Thinking through 2025, Cleveland Rocks: Past, Present, Future has much to celebrate!

The data collected through the Greater Cleveland Music Census continues to guide our work and we are proud to be a lead partner with Cuyahoga Live! ~ Cuyahoga County's new live music and entertainment task force that is dedicated to strengthening the region's vibrant music scene, supporting local artists and venues.

Partnerships defined our year and helped to support and broaden our core programming to support live local music, because **Cleveland is a Music City!** Detailed in these pages are updates and accomplishments from our busy year, including:

- In 2025, CR:PPF organized 45+ events including free community concerts, music industry workshops, songwriter showcases, mental health discussions, a street-wide music festival, and more.
- We provided on-site resources and booking opportunities to musicians at major festivals and events and collaborated through community partnerships.
- The Music Incubator program thrived with participants experiencing career highs such as embarking on regional and coastal tours, signing with independent record labels, winning prestigious awards, securing gigs at major festivals, and more.
- CR:PPF partnered with D-Tour, Live Music Society, and One Night Live to produce an 11-date regional tour in November for Music Incubator alumni Kid Tigrrr.
- Our organization helped secure funding for Mourning [A] BLKstar to tour internationally to play major festivals, as well as for archive preservation at Suma Recording – one of Cleveland's most historic recording studios.

This is all possible because of the generous gifts from the community, guided by our small, part-time team of extraordinary professionals and the volunteers and music supporters that help them ... not the least of which is our amazing group of dedicated and engaged Board of Directors.

**MUSIC ACCELERATOR PROGRAM**

**Mourning [A] BLKStar (MABS)**

In 2025, MABS was awarded a USArtists International grant through Mid Atlantic Arts with Cleveland Rocks:PPF acting as the fiscal partner. This grant covers expenses up to \$10k for their overseas tour in Jazzopen Stuttgart (Germany), North Sea Jazz Festival (Netherlands), and Colours of Ostrava (Czechia).

**Maura Rogers & The Bellows (MR&B)**

In 2025, MR&B recorded a new album with support through the CR:PPF Accelerator Program. David Kennedy was hired to engineer the project.



# MUSIC INCUBATOR PROGRAM

**The CR:PPF Music Incubator program is a micro-loan and round-table community based small music business support group.**

Local artists present project proposals, get connected with other artists and support volunteers, share ideas and opportunities, direct a conversation around their projects and music.

Artists are eligible for loans up to \$2000 for the projects they propose. Artists participate in workshops, professional development, and performance opportunities. The Music Incubator program accepts applications once a year.

In 2025, the second Incubator class was selected after fielding many applications. Ten applicants were interviewed and 7 artists/groups selected to participate. The 2025 incubator class included Goodmorning Valentine, Guy Snowdon & The Citizens, Hyperius Blake/Black Voltron, Lea Marra & The River Boys, Mr. Jeff, Nuke Franklin and Rachel Shortt.

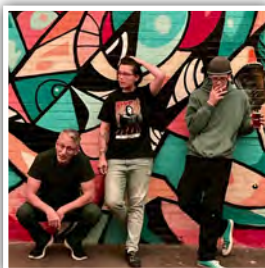

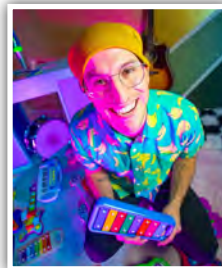

# WORKSHOP SERIES & 2X4 SONGWRITER SHOWCASES

The Professional Development Workshop series launched in 2022 to offer resources for artists to help move them forward in their career. Workshop topics include music technology, business, networking, and professional development. We have invited guest speakers and panelists to lead these workshops, as well as offer demos and interactive experiences to attendees.

Our workshop program has grown from 4 events in 2022 to 18 in 2025, which included three events dedicated to mental health and wellness. Our popular **2x4 Songwriter Showcases** returned for the second year in a row. The 2x4s feature 4 solo or duo acts performing 2 songs each directly following the workshop discussions. The workshops are recorded and the 2x4 songwriter showcases livestreamed on Facebook and YouTube.

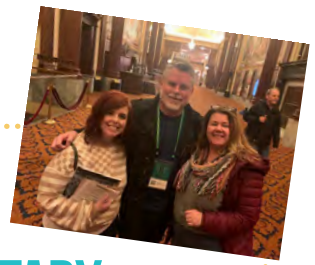

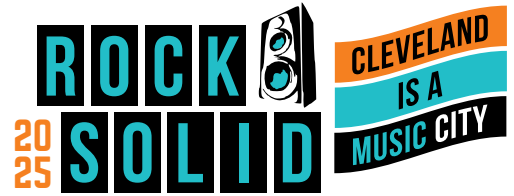

# WINTERLOO ON WATERLOO

On December 21, 2025, CR:PPF hosted our second annual winter music festival – Winterloo on Waterloo – which featured a full day of local bands and musicians performing holiday music and originals at various venues along Waterloo Rd.



Winterloo's afternoon events were all free including performances by OPUS 216, Lea Marra, Nancy Redd and the Sounds of Jazz, Black Voltron, The Super Babes, and various singer songwriters. The festival culminated at the Treelawn Music Hall with a ticketed performance by The Ohio City Singers. At each stop along the way, attendees could purchase raffle tickets to win a gift bundle which included a CR:PPF beanie, Cleveland Is A Music City poster by Joe Schorgl, and vinyl record. Through the grant from Ohio Arts Council, we were also able to provide 100 free meals at the festival.

# SOUL CITY CLEVELAND



A partnership between Cleveland Rocks: PPF, the Youth Resiliency Institute and the National Rites of Passage Institute, SOUL CITY CLEVELAND Stories is a culturally responsive community arts pilot project designed to connect youth participants residing in under-resourced communities to elder Black artists through generative immersion.

This partnership has become the foundation for programming that provides performance opportunities for Cleveland’s music legends where they share the stage and mentor Cleveland’s emerging musicians.

SOUL CITY CLEVELAND focuses on Cleveland, Ohio’s Black music icons - ages seventy and up— whose

memory links the past and the future. Featuring legendary but under-recognized artists and figures such as Lou Ragland, Art Blakey, Shirley Cook, Wallace Coleman, George Hendricks, Vel Scott, Eugene Ross and many more.

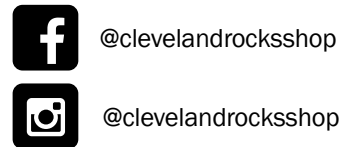

**The Cleveland Rocks Shop is a retail space for local music and merch, honoring Cleveland’s rich musical history. The store is managed by Cleveland Rocks:PPF, and sells both wholesale and consigned goods from local bands and artists. The Cleveland Rocks Shop also serves as a community gathering space for workshops and small concerts.**

2025 marked the second full year that the Cleveland Rocks Shop was open



for business as a retail store. In 2025, we hosted 21 free events in the space including 2 concerts, 1 open mic, and 18 workshops. We continue to work to expand our inventory, range of offerings, and programming to better

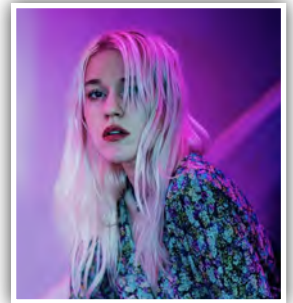
